How do we prepare our students to make decisions:

- Y9 GCSE options: Life Skills sessions on decision-making skills, knowing yourself, how to choose etc
- Y10/11 individual one-to-one interviews with Careers Team. Kudos profile. Unifrog. Help investigate which careers may be suitable/interesting, Princethorpe Careers Fair
- Y11 interviews continue. Unifrog.
- 6th Form individual interviews, talks from universities and employers, visit to UCAS Conference, Princethorpe Careers Fair.
