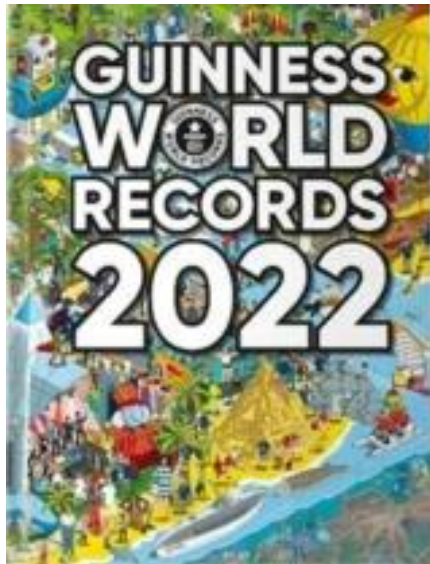
Hester is the millionaire daughter of an oil tycoon. Theo is from a long line of fishermen, struggling to make ends meet. On the face of it, the three have very little in common.
