- Spend the afternoon at the Wave Waterpark – you must be able to swim!

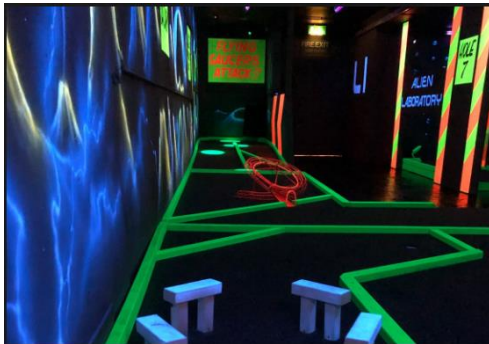




Laser Quest, Galaxy Golf and VR
