Dear Parents

This summer, Princethorpe College will be hosting a rugby training camp for boys going into Year 8, Year 9 and Year 10. The camp is offered to all boys in these year groups as it is not compulsory to attend. It is however, a great opportunity to engage in rugby after a disrupted season and a long summer break. The boys will be given the opportunity to develop the core skills of the game in addition to ensuring that the skills of contact rugby are reintroduced in a safe and effective manner.

The camp will be run by **Sports in Schools**, a company established by Matthew Price, a retired professional rugby player who now focusses on passing on this expertise onto young players across the country. This is an exciting opportunity for the boys to learn from professional players who have represented clubs at a national level. The camp is open to those pupils who will play in **next season's** U13, U14 and U15 teams (**current** Years 7, 8 and 9).

The sessions will be held at **Princethorpe College** at these times:

- Tuesday 31 August 2021, 9.00am to 3.45pm
- Wednesday 1 September 2021, 9.00am to 3.45pm
- Thursday 2 September 2021, 9.00am to 3.45pm

The cost of the training camp will be **£20 per day** to pay for the coaching services of Sports in Schools. This represents excellent value for money for the time and quality of coaching provided.
