Vocational courses (Medicine, veterinary, dentistry, physiotherapy, speech therapy, teaching etc)

- Work experience is vital can't have too much
- Can be volunteering
- Keep a log of your experiences useful for interview
- Has to demonstrate relevant skills, attributes and that you've gained an insight into what the profession is like

Making it relevant!

- Don't just list experiences in personal statement
- Reflect show what you have learned or gained from the experience
- Relate this to appropriate skills, attributes
 - e.g. teamwork, leadership, empathy, compassion etc

- Work experience/volunteering to demonstrate key competencies – use Unifrog to check your gaps

- Start researching which companies you might be interested in – some will start recruitment process in September
