


My School Portal - Updates and new Features

The College is please to inform parents of some new features and updates in My School Portal which will help parents to support their children with homework and organisation and bring key information into one easy view.

Homework

We have recently moved to a new homework view in MSP, which shows all homework tasks by date and status, making it easy to see what homework is upcoming, overdue or completed.

You can filter the homework tasks by class, Status, or Date range, as below, and toggle between outstanding and completed homework. You can also sort homework by due date.



Please note that any classes that do not have homework set this academic year will not appear in the class list. For parents of children in Years 10 to 13, some classes may show the year code of the year below, where a Team has been carried over from Year 10 or Year 12, rather than a new team being used for Year 11 or 13. Your child should be aware that the previous year's team is still being used, and still complete the homework from these Teams.

If your child has homework that is showing as 'outstanding' but they have in fact completed this, please ask them to click the 'hand in' or 'turn in' button on the assignment on Teams. Clicking hand-in/turn-in changes the status to submitted, and the homework would no longer show as outstanding. It is good practice for pupils to ensure they click hand-in/turn-in on completed work once it is done.



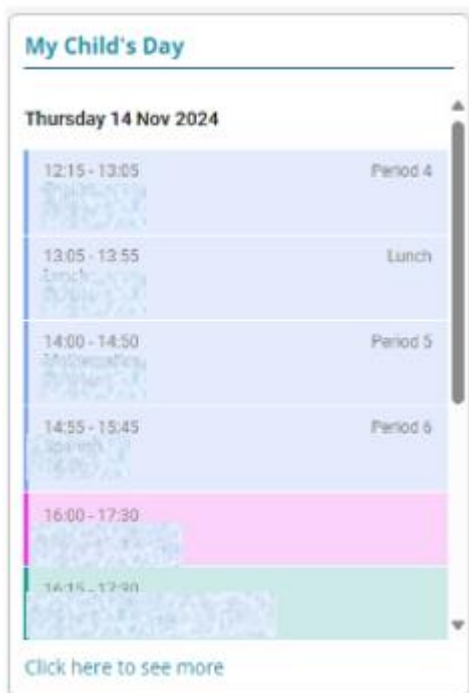
My Child's Day

We have recently configured and added the Day Planner feature into My School Portal, under the title of 'My Child's Day'.

This widget shows the timetable, co-curricular clubs and sports fixtures of your child, all in one single view. This makes it easy for parents to know what their child will be doing on any particular day, which can help with organisation of the day and planning collection from school.

You can find this under the 'My Children' section of My School Portal.

Items in blue are from the timetable, pink are co-curricular activities and green are sports fixtures. Detentions are also shown, in red.



By clicking into this, you can see a view where you can select any day over the next 2 weeks, and can see multiple children, if you have more than one child at Princethorpe.
