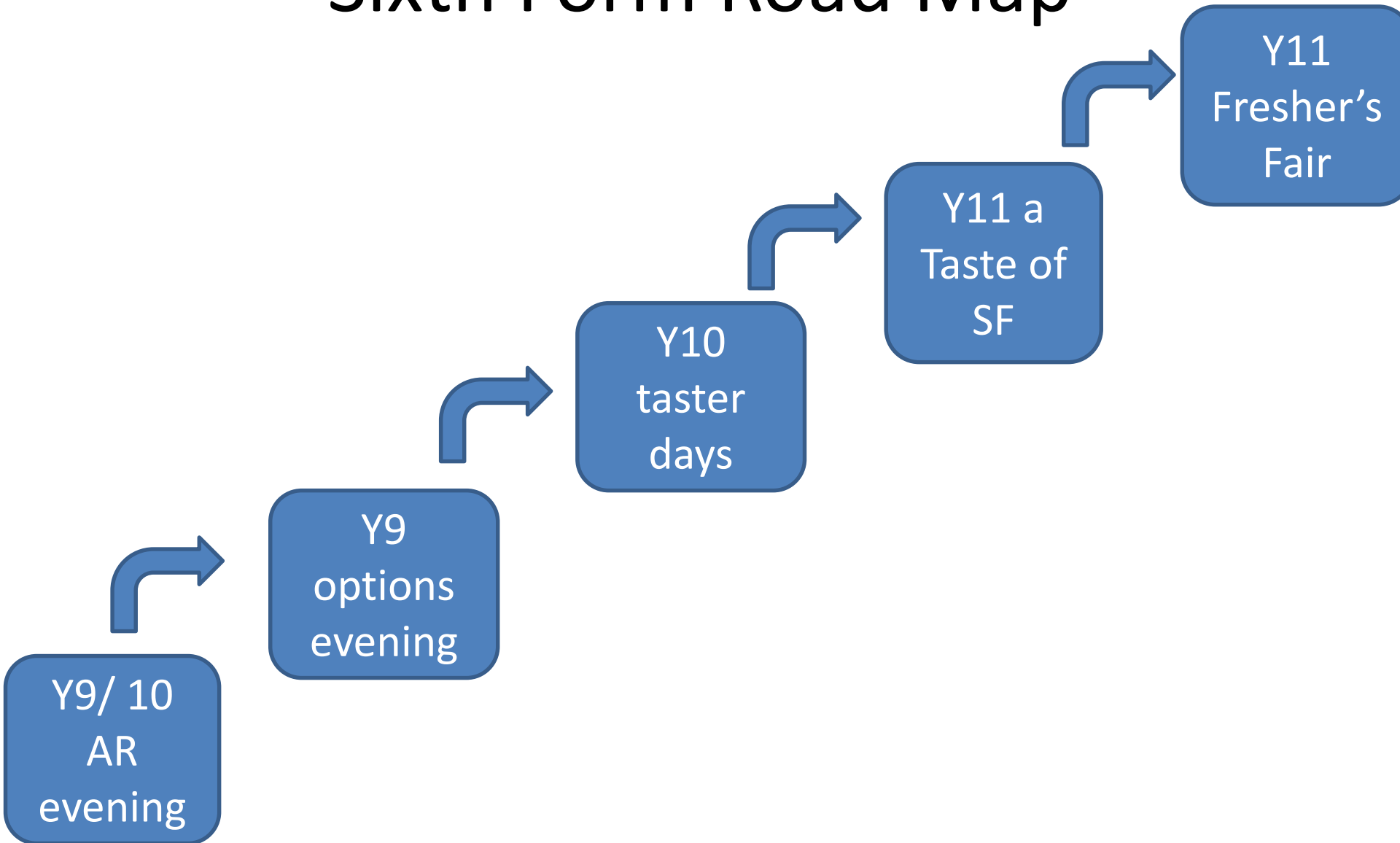
A-level results 2017

Our admissions requirements

- Minimum academic requirement is six GCSEs grades A* – C (9 – 5), including at least three B (6) grades or equivalent.
- Candidates will normally have at least grade B (6) in subjects to be studied to A-level, but it is necessary to have at least a grade A (7) in:
 - Mathematics
 - Latin
 - Modern Foreign Languages
 - Sciences
- Check each subject for specific requirements
